
Financial Planning for Your Pet

Planning For Your New Pet

Thinking about adding a new member to your family is an exciting experience whether you are new to owning pets or already have some four-legged family members. When planning to add a new pet to the family, there are several essentials your pet needs, such as food, water, bedding, toys, and healthcare. This includes vaccines, parasite preventatives, general checkups, routine spay/neuter or dental cleanings, and senior wellness visits as your pet ages.

While there are many planned healthcare needs, what happens when our pets are sick or injured? Planning for these unplanned needs lessens the load on a family for care of their loved one when they need veterinary attention most.



Benefits to Financial Planning

The health and wellness of your pet is important for an extended and healthy life with the family. Having your finances in order before your pet is in an immediate need makes for a lot less stress on family members and more focus on the importance of your pet's health. Having prepared finances can speed up time for diagnoses or treatment which speeds up recovery for your pet.

With financial planning in advance or budgeting for your pet, it is easier to maintain their routine wellness needs and has you prepared for those unplanned illnesses. Whether this is a small episode, such as urinary tract infection, or a more serious situation involving a surgery or hospitalization, we can plan ahead for our pet's needs with different types of financial planning.

Examples of Financial Planning for Your Pet



- Average yearly vet costs for pets' general wellness ranges from \$100-250, depending on age and level of care. Sick pet visits can average \$250-600 or more, depending on severity of illness.
- Budget out a certain amount for your pet monthly for routine needs and some extra for the unexpected needs. This can include a separate bank account, piggy bank, adding a monthly credit to your pet's account at their veterinarian, etc.
- Pet Insurance – While this does not work exactly like human medical insurance, having a cut to the overall costs can be worth it. It usually works as a reimbursement and works great when paired with a pet healthcare budget.
- Credit Card/CareCredit – Having a credit card or setting up a Care Credit account for your pet's health needs can help deal with cost immediately and give you more time to pay off veterinarian.
